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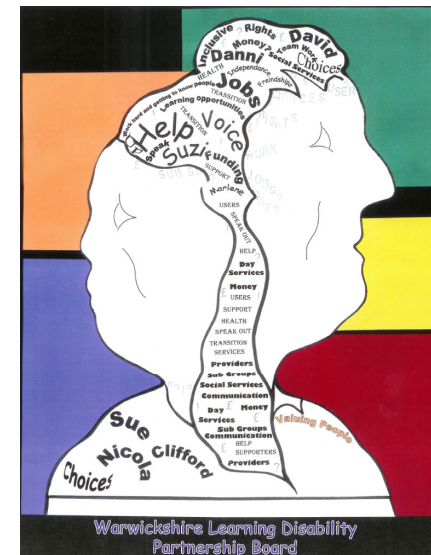

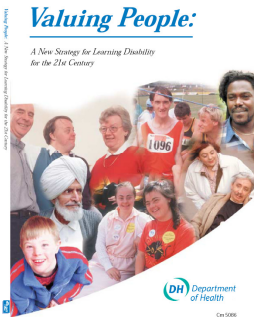

Who we are and what we do

What we do

The Warwickshire Learning Disability Partnership Board aims to:



- Make sure that the priorities of Valuing People Now happens with the help of their delivery plan which will improve the quality of lives of people with a Learning Disability living in Warwickshire



- The Board will bring together local plans and partnerships to make sure service providers and the community work well together to meet local needs and priorities.



- Make sure that people with a Learning Disability play an active part in the planning and development of services set out in Valuing People Now.



5. Community Support Services

Make sure and monitor that Valuing People Now and quality services are happening for people with Learning Disabilities.



6. Choices and Voices

This group looks at how to make information easier to understand and how to increase awareness of the advocacy plan in Valuing People Now.



7. Transition

This group have set up a project to help children move towards adult services.

Partnership Board



- The Board has set up new groups in 2009 and these will soon be in up and running-they include: Transport, Safeguarding, Relationships and Leisure.



- The Board will support and involve people from other cultures and minority groups.

What we do

- The Partnership Board has set up the following sub-groups to carry out the work of Valuing People Now

1. Health

- The group will work to make sure that people with Learning Disabilities receive good healthcare and get the support they need to live healthy lives

2. Housing

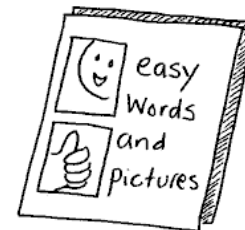
- The group will work on helping people with Learning Disabilities have an informed choice about where and with whom they live

3. Jobs

The group looks at how the pathway to work can be made better for people with learning disabilities and the different options available.

4. Person Centred Planning

This group are looking at how to make Person Centred Working part of all organisations.



- Make sure there are the right subgroups such as: safeguarding, health and wellbeing, transport, relationships, leisure, jobs and education; these will help to make Valuing People Now happen. These may change from time to time as some work is short term and other work may be ongoing.
- Be seen as an expert on learning disability information to help other services understand how to include people with learning disabilities when planning and making decisions about services.
- The Board will encourage all people to have their documents in easy read with pictures and where possible audio versions too.

The members of the Partnership Board include:



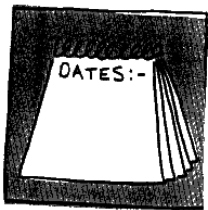
- People with a learning disability
